Alumni - Staff Meeting, presided over by the principal Dr. D.N. Dewari was conducted on 05/04/22 at 11 a.m. College Staff members also attended the meeting. At the outset the principal welcomed all the members. Thereafter, various curricular and co-curricular activities and infrastructural facilities were discussed in detail. Thereafter, the Alumni Association was formed unanimously. The highlights of the meeting are as under:

1. With a view to increasing the number of students about six Higher Secondary Schools have been visited so far.
2. English as a Principal Subject will be started from the Academic Year 2022-23.
3. Damar (macadamized) road from the highway to the college is constructed.
4. 110 new benches have been procured from KCG, Ahmedabad.
5. Boys and girls hostels, with a capacity of 50 students each, with free boarding and lodging facilities have been working since Academic Year 2019-20. The measurement of the site in front of the college campus is taken for the construction of the girls hostel. The construction is expected to start soon.
6. Repair of campus light is completed.
7. The roofs of students' and staff parking were completely ruined. New sheets are fitted with the help of R&B.
8. The tin sheets of the roof over staircase having damaged greatly, caused heavy leakage of



rainwater. The problem is resolved with the help of R&B by replacing the old sheets with the new ones.

9. Phase balancing work is accomplished with the help of R&B.

10. Various activities/competitions were organised under Udash, Placement and Saptdharma.

11. Finishing School Training is completed.

12. Innovation Club is formed. Prof. Manojkumar P. Patel attended a two-day workshop on 25/03/2022 and 26/03/2022 at Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat. 10 students of the college attended a 15 day Annual Navsajjan online training from 24/01/2022 to 23/02/2022 under Innovation Club.

13. The activities under Panchprakalp were organised in six villages in the academic year 2021-22.

14. Special Annual Camp was held at Chavasada village from 23/02/2022 to 01/03/2022.

15. Recognition certificate is conferred on 12 N. S. S. volunteers, N. S. S. Programme officer Mr. Sandipkumar N. Tandel, Dr. P. B. Kurkutia and the institution by "Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education - Department of Higher Education, Government of India" for rendering psychosocial support to the Covid-19 patients and their family during Covid-19 June-July 2021.



Consequent upon the request of the institution to resolve water crisis, the Mamlatdar Sahab Kaporada forwarded the institutions request through the Taluka Development officer, Kaporada to Honourable Prayojana Vahivatdar, Valsad. Accordingly, steps to start an alternative water source for the institution is initiated. But the institution will strive for the availability of water through Astol Planning.

17. The institution has requested R&B Valsad to provide a plan estimate for construction of a playground on 5.71 acre uneven, rough land allotted to the institution about 200 meters away from the campus so that the same may be forwarded to the government for the construction of the ground.

18. During Covid-19 Lockdown online teaching was imparted. Syllabus related topics were shared with the students through Whatsapp who could not attend online classes due to network issue. Their doubts were resolved telephonically. The links of the experts lectures were shared with them. PPT was also shared through M.S. Team.
 19. Smart Classes are sanctioned for the institution under "Navi Babat." This will enhance teaching through I.C.T.
 20. Twenty Plastic chairs will soon be delivered to the college.
 21. Fire Safety appliances will be installed ^{holobully} in the institution completely through KCG, Ahmedabad.
 22. Minor Research Project of Dr. M. K. Dharane is approved by V. N. S. G. Univ. Surat.
 23. 23 Students of the college participated in the Placement Fair. Out of which 04 students are selected by the institution.
 24. Jadhav Manishaben Mukundbhai Academic Year (2019-20) and Nikulia Pannaben Rameshbhai Academic Year (2020-21) were awarded Merit Scholarship Rs 1000/- and Rs. 3000/- respectively.
 25. Besides Namo Wi-Fi the college also has BSNL Air optic. ID and Password are shared with the students.
 26. Video Conferencing Hall is connected with the Air optic.
