Inauguration:

The initiative began with the ceremonial plantation led by the Principal of the College, Shri Manoj Patel, who inaugurated the event by planting various vegetable and flower plants in the college garden. He addressed the students and staff, speaking about the harmful effects of chemical fertilizers and pesticides on the environment and human health. He emphasized the value of returning to traditional and nature-friendly farming practices.

Activities Conducted:

After the inauguration, all faculty members, NSS volunteers, and students actively participated in planting a wide variety of vegetables, flowers, and fruit-bearing plants across the college campus. The plantation included seasonal vegetables like brinjal, okra, tomato, chili, spinach, and gourds, along with marigold and sunflower plants and fruit plants such as papaya, lemon, and banana.

The activity also included:

- Preparation of organic compost using dry leaves and waste from the campus.
- Installation of organic manure pits for future use.
- A brief demonstration session on natural fertilizers and pest repellents like jeevamrut and dashparni ark.

Objectives of the Programme:

- To create awareness about the benefits of natural farming and chemical-free agriculture.
- To encourage eco-consciousness among students and staff.
- To utilize college campus land for productive green practices.
- To contribute to the Green Campus Mission and environmental sustainability.
- To promote self-reliance and skill-building among students in farming and gardening techniques.
