IQAC meeting presided over by the principal Dr. D.N. Dewari was held on 12/03/2024 at 9.45 a.m. IQAC Committee was also formed. Mr. Jitin Sathe, ACPE, BAIK Kafarada, attended the meeting as a special member along with other members. At the outset, the principal welcomed all the members and thereafter he discussed various curricular and co-curricular activities organised in the institution and the infrastructural facilities available in the college. The highlights of the meeting are as under:

6. Inclusion of esteemed NGO, BAIK, dedicated to the uplift of the tribal community of Kafarada area, in the college IQAC Committee is a matter of great honour. Earlier, the college received utmost help and guidance from Sathe Saheb and his staff under when the college organised

a programme at Mandva village under Panchprakalp.

On the celebration of International Woman's Day at BAIF Campus on 11/03/2024 which was presided over by Honourable MLA, Kaparada, Mr. Jitubhai Chaudhary, the Principal of this institution, while addressing a group of about 1000 women, stated that they would be related to the college students as mothers/aunts/sisters/neighbours and called upon them to prove themselves as emancipated women by way of motivating students to attend college regularly so as to receive quality education and also to ensure their all-round development. Besides, he brought to the notice of all the men and women assembled in the BAIF Campus that the college had started English as a major subject in the Academic Year 2022-23. But he regretted the poor number of students in the English Main. He argued that all the students in 12th Standard had to read English compulsorily as a subject. So, those good at studies should opt for English Main in the forthcoming Academic year 2024-25.

Need for Science college at Kaparada was also discussed in the meeting.
