Alumni- Staff Meeting, presided over by the Principal, Dr. D. N. Dewari was held on 24/04/2023 at 10.30 a.m. Alumni Association was also formed. Staff members also attended the meeting. At the outset the principal welcomed all the members. Thereafter, various curricular and co-curricular activities and infrastructural facilities were discussed in detail. The highlights of the entire meeting are as under:

With a view to increasing the number of students, the college has started to pay a visit to various high schools for the last two-three years. The achievements, the curricular and co-curricular activities that take place in the college are discussed with the students of 12th standard and they are encouraged to join the said college after they pass their 12th exam. The college has introduced English as a principal subject from Academic Year 2022-23. Presently, 10 students are studying English as a principal subject. Hopefully, the number of such students will increase in future.

The college has achieved remarkable success to manage water from the Astol Scheme in the Academic Year 2022-23, which includes procurement of a pipeline from the main water tank, situated about 500 metres from college campus to the underground water tank of the college. Currently, the college receives water from three sources, including the Astol Scheme. This is a matter of great joy for the entire college.

The college has managed to procure 01 xerox machine, 01 Smart Class, 01 innovation club cupboard in the current academic year. With the use of smart class the students can gain updated information. Besides, a grant of Rs. 52,000/- is also allocated for Innovation club by KCG, Ahmedabad. The college has ordered 01

CWBC Convener, Dr. M.K. Dharme takes absolute care of the female students. Under EOC, the EOC Convener Dr. P.B. Kurkulia is always prepared to ensure that all SC/ST/OBC students, studying in the college get an equal opportunity.

Educational tour to historical places, namely Ajanta-Elora, Daulatabad and Dhushmeshwar was arranged from 08/02/2023 to 11/02/2023. Later, Prof. D.V. Patel arranged a power-point presentation, which included the photographs and the elaborate discussion especially for those who could not join the tour.

Out of 27 students who participated in the Mega Placement Fair on 17/03/2023 held at Degree Engineering College, Valsad, 08 students were selected. Out of the grant Rs. 30,000/- received in the current academic year for the purchase of books, a sum of Rs. 26368/- has been utilized for the purchase of new books.

On 26/12/2022 NSS Campus Ambassador, Nikulia Santoshbhai Ramesh paid a visit to Adi Chunchanagiri University, Bellur, Karnataka and on 25/01/2023 he was honoured as best Campus Ambassador by honourable District Collector, Valsad. With a view to ensuring all-round development of the students various competitions/programmes were held under Saptadhara, Udisha/Placement, G3 Quiz, Panchprakalp, Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav, G20, Finishing School, SCOPE. G3 Quiz and Saptadhara Co-ordinator Mr. D.V. Patel, Udisha/Placement, Panchprakalp Co-ordinator Mr. S.N. Tandel, Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav Co-ordinator Mr. V.R. Vasava, Finishing School and SCOPE Co-ordinator Mrs. K.A. Patel in collaboration with the principal and with the help of the staff did an excellent work.

Senior clerk, Mr. V.B. Jadav did all the student-related and administrative work with utmost sincerity. Besides, Examination and all other activities have also accomplished noteworthy performance. The college is committed

to accomplish renovation of the college building and playground in near future. In this regard the college is on the right track. PET Mr. S. N. Tandel conducted various sports activities and competitions.

N. S. S. Programme Officer Mr. A. C. Gamit organised numerous SVEEP Programmes and N. S. S. Special Camp at Dahikhed from 13/02/2023 to 19/02/2023.

The principal assured all the alumni that the college will take utmost care of students and will endeavour to boost up curricular and co-curricular activities. At last the principal thanked the alumni, staff members and concluded the meeting.

Special note: The principal discussed with the staff and alumni the projects to be undertaken under Institute Development Plan for which the college has applied, especially levelling of uneven land of college playground, completion of the incomplete boundary wall (the estimated cost about 40 lakhs), construction of 04 new classrooms (estimated cost 4 crore), establishment of computer lab, estimated cost about 35 lakhs.

The Principal gave an appropriate answer to the query raised by Mr. Kiranbhai Bhoja regarding the students of English Main. Moreover, the Principal added that he himself engaged classes and taught expediently. The students were also shown "Macbeth Film". Notably, the Principal urged all to keep an eye on him, embolden the students towards their upliftment.



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
